**TVC Outraged By California Judge's
Decision On Same-Sex Marriage**

Traditional Values Coalition Chairman Rev. Louis P. Sheldon is outraged by the decision issued by the San Francisco County Superior Court on March 15th stating that California's ban on homosexual marriage is unconstitutional.

"The decision issued by Judge Richard Kramer is yet another example of judicial tyranny and makes it clearer than ever that California—and every other state—needs a constitutional amendment to protect marriage as a union of one man and one woman," said Rev. Sheldon.

"Marriage is a social institution which is the bedrock of society—and the judicial system should never dictate social policies. This should be left to the state legislatures and the U.S. Congress," said Sheldon.

According to Kramer, "It appears that no rational purpose exists for limiting marriage in this state to opposite-sex partners."

Kramer's decision will be appealed to a higher court and will ultimately be decided by the California Supreme Court.

"Maybe this decision will serve as a wake-up call to Americans to get behind our proposed California state constitutional amendment that will ban homosexual marriages, civil unions, and any other sexual arrangements," said Sheldon. Traditional Values Coalition and legislators in the state Senate and Assembly have proposed ACA 3 and SCA 1, which are identical amendments to protect marriage from being redefined by activist judges.

"Judge Kramer's decision makes it clear that we must have a marriage protection amendment that fully protects marriage and that bans not only homosexual marriages but civil unions," noted Rev. Sheldon.
